

Albert L. Walker Award

Application Deadline: Friday, March 7, 2008

The Albert L. Walker Excellence in English Award is given annually to undergraduate and graduate students with demonstrated ability in the study of literature. In honor of Professor Walker, former chair of the Department of English, three awards of \$350 each will be awarded, one to an undergraduate English major, one to an undergraduate majoring in a subject other than English, and one to a graduate student (any major) who has taken at least one graduate course in literature at ISU.

To apply, complete this form and attach an essay of no more than 500 words, explain the way that a text of your choosing illustrates what you have found to be interesting or satisfying about your study of literature. If you are an undergraduate, provide a copy of your most recent degree audit. The selection of a recipient will be made by the members of the Walker Award Committee and will be based upon the clarity and effectiveness of the submitted essay and upon academic achievement and performance in the study of literature.

Completed undergraduate applications (including this page and a form cover sheet) should be returned to an English undergraduate advisor, or taken to 239 Ross. Graduate submissions should be returned to the Graduate Studies Office, 403 Ross Hall.
