

# Critical Writing Award

**Application Deadline: Friday, March 7, 2008**

Any undergraduate or graduate student may submit any single piece of critical exposition originally written for an English course at Iowa State University (including course papers submitted during the current academic year). The amount of the two awards varies, up to \$100 each.

Undergraduate and graduate essays will be judged separately. Criteria for evaluation include originality of thesis, command of material, and quality of exposition.

Submissions must be freshly typed, double-spaced, and no longer than 30 pages. Recommended length is 6–15 pages for undergraduate essays and 12–20 pages for graduate essays.

Completed undergraduate applications (including this page and a form cover sheet) should be returned to an English undergraduate advisor, or taken to 239 Ross. Graduate submissions should be returned to the Graduate Studies Office, 403 Ross Hall.
